- Read operator's manual.
- Keep safety devices (guards, shields, switches, etc.) in place and working.
- Go across slopes, not up or down.
- Remove objects that could be thrown by blade.
- Do not mow when children or others are around.
- Look down and behind before and while moving backwards.
- Wait at least 2 minutes before refueling.

- Keep hands and feet away from deck.
- Do not operate mower unless discharge chute or entire grass catcher is in its proper place.

Utility Knife  
Unleaded Fuel (minimum 87 octane)

### Items Included



### 1 Unpack the mower

- Cut all four corners of the box from top to bottom.
- Remove all packing materials from the mower.
- Locate and identify the items included with the mower.

**⚠ WARNING**  
Failure to read and follow instructions in the operator's manual could result in death and/or bodily injury.

### 2 Read the manuals

- Carefully read all the manuals supplied with the mower. They contain important safety, operating, and maintenance information.

### 3 Unfold the handle

- Remove the knob, lock washer, and bolt (A, Figure 1) from each side of the handle base.
- Loosen, but do not remove, the knobs (B) on the upper handle.
- Raise the handle to the operating position, and tighten the upper knobs.
- Reinsert the lower handle bolts through the handle base and handle (C, most users prefer the middle position). Install the lock washers and fully tighten the knobs.

### 4 Set up the recoil rope handle

- Hold the bail control against the handle (A, Figure 2).
- Pull the recoil rope handle out to the rope guide (B) on the handle. Hook the recoil rope into the rope guide (it might be a tight fit).

### 5 Add oil and fuel

- Move the mower outside to a flat, level surface.
- Remove the oil fill cap (A, Figure 3). Using the bottle of oil supplied in the carton, fill the engine with the proper amount of oil. (Check the dipstick on the oil fill cap.) Replace the oil fill cap.

**IMPORTANT** Mower is shipped without oil in engine.  
**Failure to add oil will result in engine damage.**

- Remove the fuel fill cap (B). Following the three-step instructions on the FreshStart™ card, snap the fuel preserver cartridge into the bottom of the fuel fill cap.
- Add clean, fresh, UNLEADED fuel with a minimum of 87 octane, leaving one inch of space from the top of the tank for fuel expansion. NOTE: Fuel blends containing more than 10% ethanol are not recommended.

**IMPORTANT** Fuel tank holds less than 1/2 gallon.  
**IMPORTANT** DO NOT mix oil with fuel.  
**IMPORTANT** DO NOT use E85 fuel.

- Replace the fuel fill cap, and wipe up any spills.

### 6 Start the mower

- Move the cutting height adjust lever (A, Figure 4) to the desired cutting height.
- Set the mower to mulch, bag, or discharge. (See 3-in-1 instructions below.)
- Hold the bail control (A, Figure 5) against the drive handle.
- Pull the recoil rope handle (B) until the engine starts.
- To engage the drive system, slowly squeeze the wheel drive control lever (C) back toward the handle. Squeezing the lever further back increases ground speed.
- To stop the engine and blade, release the bail control.

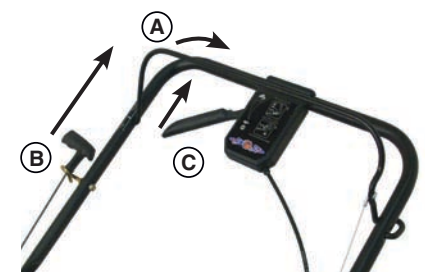

### 3-in-1: Convert from mulching to bagging to side-discharge:

#### 1 For mulching:

- Leave the side discharge cover and the installed mulch plug in place (Figure 6).

#### 2 To convert to bagging:

- Lift the rear door and remove the installed mulch plug (Figure 7).

- Holding the rear door open, attach the grass catcher to the rear of the mower (Figure 8).

- Make sure the hooks on both sides of the catcher frame hook onto the rear door rod (Figure 9).
- Release the rear door (it will lay on top of the grass catcher).

#### 3 To convert to side discharge:

- Make sure the mulch plug is installed in the rear of the mower, and the grass catcher is removed.
- Lift the side discharge cover, and install the side discharge deflector onto the mower deck (Figure 10).
- Make sure the upper tabs are hooked behind the cover rod, and the deck tab sticks up through the locking slot (Figure 11).
- Release the side discharge cover (it will lay on top of the grass catcher).
