

Add oil and fuel



IMPORTANT Mower is shipped without oil in engine. Failure to add oil will result in engine damage.

- Remove the fuel fill cap (B). Following the three-step instructions on the FreshStart[™] card, snap the fuel preserver cartridge into the bottom of the fuel fill cap.
- Add clean, fresh, UNLEADED fuel with a minimum of 87 octane, leaving one inch of space from the top of the tank for fuel expansion. NOTE: Fuel blends containing more than 10% ethanol are not recommended.

IMPORTANT Fuel tank holds less than 1/2 gallon. IMPORTANT DO NOT mix oil with fuel. IMPORTANT DO NOT use E85 fuel.

Replace the fuel fill cap, and wipe up any spills.





Start the mower

- Move the cutting height adjust lever (A, Figure 4) to the desired cutting height.
- Set the mower to mulch, bag, or discharge. (See 3-in-1 instructions below.)
- Hold the bail control (A, Figure 5) against the drive handle.
- Pull the recoil rope handle (B) until the engine starts.
- To engage the drive system, slowly squeeze the wheel drive control lever (C) back toward the handle. Squeezing the lever further back increases
- To stop the engine and blade, release the bail control.






1 For mulching:

· Leave the side discharge cover and the installed mulch plug in place (Figure 6).

2 To convert to bagging:

3 To convert to side discharge:

- Make sure the mulch plug is installed in the rear of the mower, and the grass catcher is removed.
- Lift the side discharge cover, and install the side discharge deflector onto the mower deck (Figure 10).
- Make sure the upper tabs are hooked behind the cover rod, and the deck tab sticks up through the locking slot (Figure 11).
- Release the side discharge cover (it will lav on top of the grass catcher)
